Return to Play Rules and Protocols – Phase 2

Dear Member,

Firstly may we thank you for your respect of the requirements during Phase 1.

Assuming the Government / HSE permits a move to Phase 2 on Monday 8th June 2020 the revised rules and protocols for this period are now being forwarded to you.

For simplicity the major change is that the 5km, residence restriction is extended to a radius of 20km. from the Club.

As previously advised the over 70's are permitted to play but do so at their own risk.

We wish to emphasise that each server is expected to use their own distinctly marked tennis balls and not share balls with their opponent.

We had expected that doubles play would be approved but sadly for the moment it remains singles only with the exception of the same household proviso.

Each and every member of the Club is obliged to read and acknowledge the Rules and Playing Protocols set out to maximise the safety of all.

You, the Club members, have a responsibility to each other and the wider community to do everything in your power to adhere to these standards set down for your protection.

Anyone who is seen repeatedly in breach of the standards will be requested to immediately leave the Club and will be declined re-entry during the Phase 2 period.

Finally please note that the pedal bin rubbish bag at the gate should not be used for disposal of food or food packages as we do not wish to attract wildlife.

Remain healthy and play safely at a distance.
